Code of Champions Farrington High School

Rationale: Our mission at Farrington High School is to promote high academic standards, good citizenship, mutual respect, and the attributes in "The Farrington Way". The Code of Champions will ensure that all our students, who represent Farrington High School at community, school or athletic events, will be model students who meet all the standards set forth by this policy.

Effective August 1, 2017, the following policy will be in effect throughout the year. Any student participating in a sanctioned OIA sport or chartered club at Farrington, will be held to the following standards in order to participate as a representative of Farrington High School. Participation in said sports or clubs for the following year will be reflective on the standards met at the end of the previous year.

Every week, each student will be checked on whether or not they meet all the Code of Champions criteria. In order to participate in games and/or club events, they would need to maintain ALL the following Code of Champions criteria:

- 90% attendance (no more than 2 periods of unexcused absences and/or unexcused tardies during the week)
- 2.0 GPA, no F's or U's in any classes
- No Chapter 19 (A, B, C and D) offenses.
- No financial obligations.
- Being identified in a posting (photo, video clip, etc.) to a social media site as a willing participant in illegal or inappropriate behavior (including cyber-bullying and/or harassment) is a violation of the Code of Champions.

Failure to maintain the Code of Champions will result in placement in a 1-week non-participation period (NPP) placement status. If a student is on NPP, s/he will NOT be able to participate in games or events during the 1-week NPP but will be allowed to practice and participate in team and/or club meetings. If there is a bye week, the NPP will apply to the following week as well. The student will be able to resume participation after the 1-week NPP if s/he has met all Code of Champions criteria on the next 1-week check. If the student does not meet Code of Champions criteria, the NPP will continue for an additional week and until s/he meets <u>all</u> Code of Champions criteria.

Proms, Dances – School will check only for obligations. Band, ROTC – Students not held to Code of Champions as they participate for grade

Parents/Guardians of students must sign to indicate receipt and understanding of the Code of Champions and will support their teen as they work towards excellence.
